**Re: Quarterly Inspection and Maintenance Report for Fourth Quarter 2004
Neal's Landfill, Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana**

This letter report summarizes the quarterly inspection and maintenance activities completed at the Neal's Landfill site during the fourth quarter of 2004. This report has been prepared in accordance with procedures and reporting requirements outlined in the March 2001 RCRA Cap Inspection and Maintenance Plan (CIMP) prepared by Viacom Inc. (Viacom).

Site Inspection and Maintenance Activities

The scope of inspection and maintenance work for the Neal's Landfill site is summarized in table form as Appendix B to the March 2001 CIMP. Activities listed therein comprise routine quarterly site inspections, mowing of the cap, application of herbicide along fence lines and rip-rap drainage structures, annual spring and fall fertilizer treatments, and biannual topographic surveys to evaluate settlement of the RCRA Cap over time.

A copy of the Routine Checklist Form for this inspection event is attached. This form documents conditions and maintenance needs at the time this quarterly inspection was completed on December 21, 2004. A Non-routine Maintenance Report is used to document non-routine maintenance activities completed during the quarter. No non-routine maintenance tasks were performed for the fourth quarter 2004. For this reason, no Non-routine Maintenance Report is included.

Routine maintenance during the fourth quarter of 2004 was limited to a mowing of the landfill cap, trimming along surface drainage ditches, around piezometers and landfill gas vent structures, and the application of annual herbicide and fall fertilizer treatments.

No major maintenance issues were observed during the site inspection on December 21. As stated in previous inspection reports, there are a few areas of accumulated sediment in the surface water drainage ditches on the cap as well as the perimeter run-on ditches, particularly along the east ditch and over the east end of the north ditch. However, none of these conditions are affecting the function or performance of the ditches at this time.

Non-routine repairs completed during the third quarter of 2004 (limited sod, seed and erosion mat placement) appeared to be in very good condition.
